

The Axis of Resistance is a network of Iranian-backed militias and political groups in the Middle East, formed by Iran by uniting and grooming armed groups that are dedicated to confront the influence of the United States and Israel in the Middle East, and shares hostility toward the countries.

- Syrian Arab Republic (before the regime change)
- Islamic Resistance in Iraq (Multiple Iraqi groups)
- Ansar Allah (Houthi clan in Yemen)
- HAMAS





My Perspective

- Network of organizations; Iran guides, but may not control
- Sharing rhetorical ideology: opposition to US influence and presence of Israel in Middle East.
- Using techniques of terrorism to remain relevant in Middle East. Less concerned with protecting Palestinians than with retaining power.
- Continuing evolution of threat: action-reaction-counteraction.
- Syria Internal conflict limits external influence?





Prognostication?

Three-dimensional Chess?

Iran will continue to oppose US interests (indirectly) and Israel (more directly) but will walk careful line to avoid Israeli attacks.

- HAMAS will continue to provoke Israeli overreaction as technique to "prove" its relevance.
- Hezbollah will take advantage of Israeli focus on HAMAS to maintain its relevance.
- Houthis will continue to attack Red Sea maritime trade as messaging to international community: "we're still here!"
- Syria will seek support/assistance; internal chaos will limit ability to exert influence.
